The Sarsen Trail is an annual Spring Bank Holiday country walk in aid of Wiltshire Wildlife Trust. Organised by volunteers, the Trail follows a 26-mile route across undulating Wiltshire countryside with stunning views across the Vale of Pewsey and the Avon Valley. The unique route links two of the UK's World Heritage sites - the ancient stone circles of Avebury and world-famous Stonehenge. The route is a multi-terrain, undulating cross-country course of moderate severity and may be very muddy in wet weather and dusty and rutted when dry.

Now in its nineteenth year, The Sarsen Trail has become the Trust's largest annual fundraising event, with over 2,000 people taking part to raise funds for conservation work in Wiltshire.

Wiltshire Wildlife Trust is one of the UK's most successful nature conservation charities. Over the last 45 years, we have created over 30 wildlife havens, effectively lobbied local and national government and dramatically reduced waste in Wiltshire.

The choice of route is yours...

- 1 Walkers may choose to undertake the full event
Avebury to Stonehenge 26 miles...
or
- 2 either of the two stages...
Avebury to Redhorn Hill 11 miles or
Redhorn Hill to Stonehenge 15 miles

A free coach service is available between start and finishing points (see inside for details).

1 Decide... where you want to start and finish

Avebury to Stonehenge 26 miles
Average time 8 - 9 hours

or

Avebury to Redhorn 11 miles
Average time 3 - 4 hours

or

Redhorn to Stonehenge 15 miles
Average time 4 - 5 hours

Water is available at points along the Trail. **Light refreshments** are available at Redhorn and Stonehenge.

If you intend to walk the whole 26 miles, we strongly recommend that **you start before 09.00**. Walkers should complete the route to Stonehenge by 18.00. **After this time, we cannot guarantee that facilities will still be available.**

As a guide, all walkers should leave the Bustard checkpoint by 17.00. Transport will be available at the Bustard checkpoint for those who are unable to complete the walk by 18.00.

3 Complete... the registration form

Registration forms will be available to download from the website. For early bird prices, the form needs to be completed and sent in **before Monday 16th April 2007** enclosing a cheque to cover entry fees. After this date walkers can only register on the day. **Cheques should be made payable to 'Wiltshire Wildlife Trust'.**

Children under 16 years old **MUST** be accompanied by an adult. There are several busy roads and a mainline railway to cross.

PLEASE enclose an A5 stamped-addressed envelope to the value of 60p.

NOTE You can use the same registration form for other adults/children at the same address, only if you start together and have the same transport requirements.

2 Decide... your transport arrangements

We advise that participants park vehicles at the finishing point and make use of our free coach service between there and the start points. Check the maps on the back of this form.

Please state your intended parking point on your registration form and you will be sent a parking voucher.

Vehicles are parked entirely at the owners' risk.

Walkers intending to complete the full route who decide to finish at Redhorn instead, may do so. However we cannot offer transport from Redhorn to Stonehenge before 12.30pm.

Please note that a one-way traffic system will be in operation from Redhorn Hill to Upavon (A342). Follow the signs as marked. This is to ease traffic congestion and prevent accidents. The track along the edge of Salisbury Plain can be very rough and potholed. **Vehicles used along this track entirely at owner's risk.**

Dogs are welcome on the coaches but must be kept under control at all times.

If you're registering on the day, collect your free coach pass from the registration point before boarding.

4 Once we receive... your registration money

Upon receipt of your registration form and entry fee you will be sent your record card and confirmation of registration, together with a note of your transport arrangements. **PLEASE CHECK THESE CAREFULLY** - if there are any errors or you wish to alter your requirements, please call the Trust office on **(01380) 725670**.

Please check-in under the name of the lead person registered on this form.

To make use of the free coach service you will need a **BUS PASS**. These are sent to you as a tear-off section on your record card when you register. All participants must register before boarding a coach.

Avebury start...

You must check-in between

▶ **07.00 - 10.00**

The Check-in Point is at the Study Centre behind the Great Barn. If you are walking the full 26 miles, we strongly recommend you start before 09.00.

Redhorn Hill start...

You must check-in between

▶ **09.30 - 11.00**

THE SMALL PRINT!

The Check-in Points will not open before these times. If you change your mind about your start point, you will need to check-in at the late entries desk on the day.

Your record card will be signed by marshals at the check points along the route. This provides you with proof you have completed the walk. Everyone who finishes the full or half distance will **receive a medallion**, also **free entry** to **Stonehenge** monument.

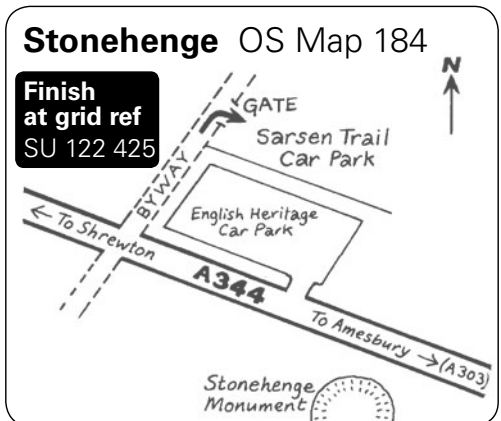
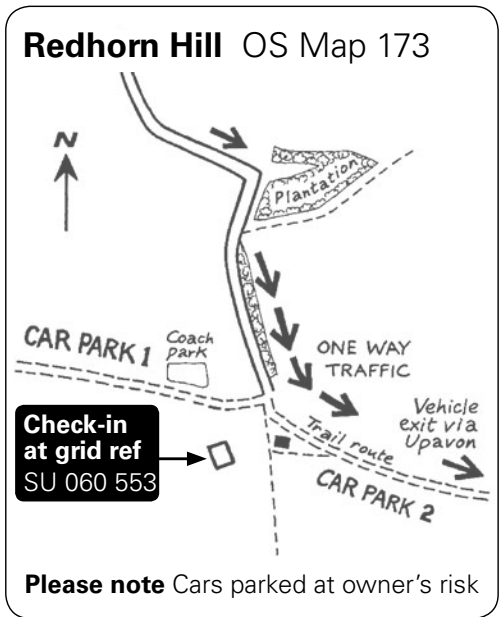
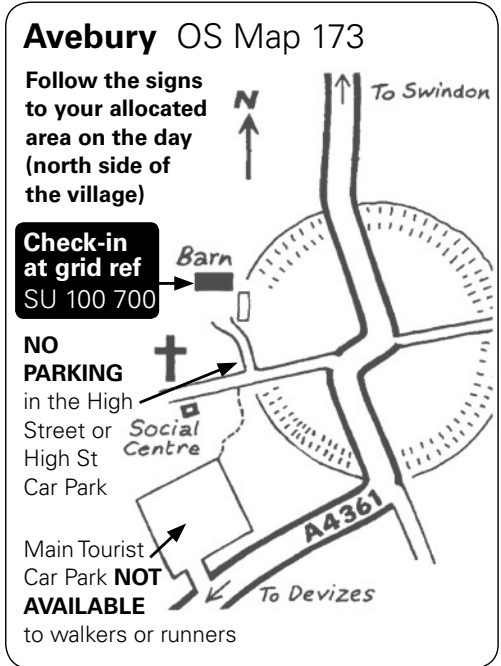
After Casterley Camp, you will be passing through the MoD Danger Area. **Please keep to the route, remember the Country Code and keep dogs strictly under control.**

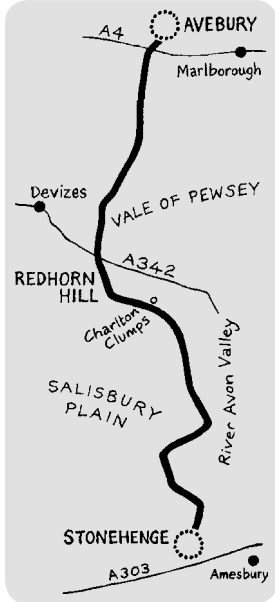
